

2018 Scholarship - Professional

The Georgia Chapter of the International Concrete Repair Institute (ICRI) will **award up to \$1,000 in Educational Reimbursement Scholarship to a current member of GA ICRI**. The mission of ICRI is to improve the quality of repair, restoration and protection of concrete and other structures. This Education Reimbursement Scholarship program helps our members complete this mission by continuing to improve our member's certifications, continuing education, and professional development for those members. To this end, we are proud to offer this Educational Reimbursement Scholarship to current members who are attending professional development courses, certification classes, or examinations such as Professional Engineering Exam, Professional Certifications (ACI, ICRI, ASA, etc.), Learning Modules or workshops (ex. Taking a PAID class on injection or surface prep), or other.

Qualification: Current Members participating in any continuing educational classes, training, or certification programs from November 1, 2017 to October 31, 2018. Any applicant must send in completion certificate from course taken or receipt from course and a brief written/electronic description of the class and the relation to the ICRI mission statement above. Only one entry per year can be submitted for each applicant. Current ICRI-GA chapter board members are exempt from registering.

Selection: To avoid any conflicts of interest, applicants will be selected at random. Each applicant will have the same opportunity as the next to win. Applicant's names will be submitted into our drawing which is held at the annual Christmas Party. Attendance is mandatory to be selected!!

\$200 Member Professional Development Awards:

1. Applicants must be a member of the Georgia Chapter of ICRI
2. Must submit the receipt from an Industry approved or sanctioned professional development event related to concrete restoration.
 - i. This includes, but is not limited to, National conventions, seminars, and training.
3. Must submit a 300 word or less summary of what the event was and what knowledge was gained.
4. All submission will be entered in a drawing and (5) will be selected at random at the Christmas Party.
 - i. Attendance is mandatory to be awarded!

Additional Rules:

1. No ICRI-GA board member is permitted to enter.
2. Each ICRI-GA Member can only submit one application per year.
